

Dear Hunters for the Hungry Supporter,

Your gifts to our charity have played an essential role in our ability to provide quality nutrition to those in need here in Virginia. Since the inception of Hunters for the Hungry in 1991, the program has processed and distributed over 28.8 million servings of high protein, low fat venison to church food pantries, food banks, Salvation Army and other programs that reach out to help our neighbors going through tough times. Your compassion and generosity made that happen!

Because of your efforts and those of others like you, we were able to provide over a million servings of venison this past season! You can imagine what this meant to people who were struggling to feed their families.

At this time, our funds are extremely low. To date, we have received 256,586 pounds of venison this hunting season. We are continuing to receive bills from processors for deer taken late in the season and in some areas, from the extended hunting season which will end on March 29. We will also be receiving deer from damage permit harvests in areas where the deer are overpopulated. Any help you could give us right now would be such a blessing and very much appreciated. In additional to mailing, donations can also be made by credit card through our website.

Other ways to support our program are through our merchandise and raffle ticket sales. We have enclosed an order form for each. The entire merchandise line can be viewed on our website. NFAA Tournament Updates: Cancellations & Postponements

.Bottom line up front is VBA needs a primary and alternate hunting POC from each Club that I can pass to VDGIF

More info: VDGIF gets phone calls and emails from folks across the state wanting to get into bowhunting but these beginners don't know where to start. VDGIF wants to direct these folks to the closest VBA Club. It is a great way to bring new folks into archery and bowhunting and a great source of new members for each Club.

VDGIF, in the form of David Dodson, Mindy Tucker, and Jason Miller, came to speak to the VBA Delegates at the January meeting

They are interested in partnering with VBA. They explained they get a fair amount of calls from folks wanting to start archery hunting but they don't know where to start. They said that typically, these folks are in their early 20s, but it is possible to get folks older and/or younger. VBA would like to vector those folks to VBA Clubs. The person would contact the Club and then visit and link up with folks at the Club. Their visit could range from just talking about what bow to buy to archery instruction to how to put up a stand. There is no requirement to take the person hunting (but that is certainly acceptable if the Club wanted to do that). I don't think there is a huge number of folks calling VDGIF; meaning I don't think we'll be overwhelmed with hundreds of folks wanting to talk to a Club. It's probably more like a few a month.

This is a good thing for both organizations: It brings new, younger folks in to bowhunting and/or archery and is a source of new members for the Club and VBA.

Both us and VDGIF want a good "hand-off" of the person from VDGIF to the Club so we don't lose the person in the middle. The idea is we have a few folks designated at each Club that the new hunter could contact and link up with.

It is key that the designated folks understand that they are designated and understand the expectation. What we do not want is a prospective hunter to contact a Club and be told "We don't know what you're talking about". I think the chances are slim of that because it seems every Club I've talked to WELCOME new shooters/hunters and can't wait to help them get started shooting.

ACTION:

We'd like each Club to designate a couple folks as POCs for this. I'll pass the list to VDGIF along with a map of where each of our Clubs are, and then VDGIF will vector people that contact them to the right Club and POC. I need name, email, and phone. Can be yourself if you want; there's no restrictions there. We just want someone that understands what we're trying to do and that can honcho the new shooter/hunter into the Club to the right folks to get them started.
