- I swear I didn't hit the release. It went off on its own!
- "Honest, that's where I was aiming"

- My serving slipped
- Nocking point moved
- Broke a strand in my string/cables
- Level's not working correctly
- I'm working on my form
- It's farther/closer than I thought (best used on a marked distance course!)
- That tree was not there when I shot
- Did you see that target turn
- Damn it, they put the kill in the wrong place
- Well, if I was hunting this animal I would not have put the ten ring there!!!!
- If I only had five more pounds I would of made that shot
- My bow is doing 285fps.....If I had 5 fps more I would have made that shot
- Did you see that squirrel run across the top of the target just before I let loose of the shot?
- Crap, I set my sight for 36 yards. Oh, it IS 36 yards? Then I must have set my site for 35 yards.
- it was a ten when it left the bow
- They are just not going where I point them
- The heat here at the range has made my string stretch and my nock moved. You should see me on a cold day.
- My Arrows And My Bow Were Having A Little Disagreement
- My wife won't let me practice in the living room anymore!
- Just as I was locked on the inner 10 and was about to release there was an earth tremor!
- I didn't want to mess up your nocks. So I missed it on purposes.
- These new arrows haven't been trained yet, they keep going where I'm aiming instead of where they are supposed to be going!!
- Why my arrows are all over the target? Because there is so much space to place them!
- Oh, wait a second, these are my practice arrows!
- The wind was blowing from the back and my hair got in the way of my eyes!
- I had one white index vane and two black vanes. I was shooting well in practice, but on the tournament day the sun came out, and caused the black vane to heat up and expand, causing more drag on that vane, throwing the arrows off balance.
